What we do:

Science ALIVE is a not-for-profit science education program based out of Simon Fraser University's Burnaby campus. The goal of the program is to **expose youth** to the exciting worlds of **SCIENCE, ENGINEERING, and TECHNOLOGY** and to **inspire** them to want to learn more. Science ALIVE develops exciting hands-on activities that are completely different from what kids experience at school. Science ALIVE runs many programs throughout the year, including summer camps in July and August.

We are currently looking for high school instructors (paid and volunteer positions available) to support our summer camps, which run from July 5th – August 27th, 2010.

Job Descriptions – What you can do:

Volunteer: This position requires a commitment of at least two full weeks of volunteering with our summer camps (Mon to Fri: 8:30 am – 3:30 pm), plus 2 days of training. It will involve assisting instructors in the running of camp, as well as leading games and the general supervision of campers. Accepted volunteers will gain valuable experience working with kids and in science labs, and be exposed to the university environment all in a fun and dynamic atmosphere.

Interested candidates must currently be in/completing grades 9-12, and must undergo a successful group interview before being selected to volunteer for the program.

High School Instructor: This is a paid position and requires a full time commitment for 2 months, from the end of June (after exams) until August 27th. In this position, you will gain the experience of working in an amazing team to develop and implement hands-on science activities for the summer camps, and gain experience teaching science to children. You will also be responsible (with other leaders) for the safety and entertainment of the children.

Interested candidates must currently be in/completing grades 11 or 12, and must undergo a successful group and personal interview before being selected to work with the program.

What we are looking for:

If you are interested in science, engineering, and technology, and would like to spend the summer having fun with kids and getting them excited about science, this is the job for you! We are looking for individuals who are enthusiastic, responsible, and good with kids.
